## Game Day Procedures 2021

### COVID-19 Competition



## **2021 COVID-19 Netball Season:**

This Competition Game Day Procedures document is to set out the requirements to run our competition in a COVID-19 safe way and to comply with legislated requirements for community sports.

The Netball New South Wales Covid-19 Safety Plan Return to Play Guidelines document should be read in conjunction with this document.

Campbelltown District Netball Association (CDNA) Executive is committed to our members and visitor's health and safety and has developed procedures for that purpose.

Please follow all directions and displayed guidelines so everyone may enjoy their Netball experience.

We encourage all attendees at Coronation Park - Minto Netball Complex to download the COVIDSafe App.

You may also access our Covid Safe Plan on our website or a copy is located in the foyer of the complex.

### **General Principals:**

**Venue: Coronation Park – Minto Netball Complex**

### **Facility Attendance:**

The current legislation establishes the maximum number of people allowed at an outdoor sporting complex as 3000. The previous use of zones will no longer apply.

### **Court usage and Numbers:**

Each Court can be utilised for Training and Competition. However, we have spread out the courts for Saturday's competition.

### **The following assumptions are used:**

**Players 7, + Substitutes 2 = 9 x 2 teams = 18**

**Coaches and Managers 2 per Team = 4**

**Umpires = 2**

**Scorers = 2**

**Parents and Spectators = 36**

**Average total of people per Game = 62**

**We strongly suggest that Players and Spectators sit on opposite sides of the courts.**

**Parking and Court Access:**

All vehicles must be parked within the designated car spaces. The front row of parking spaces are for our Association delegates ONLY.

**NO PARKING** is permitted along the fence lines at anytime. This is a danger for everyone.

**Team Officials and Players:**

All players, coaches, team officials, technical officials and volunteers are required to register and provide contact details through Netball Australia's National online registration system – My Netball.

**At the completion of the game, ALL players and spectators are to leave the venue immediately. If a player has to stay for the next time slot then they should proceed to the court allocated.**

**Spectators & Visitors:**

QR code registrations must be utilized by all spectators prior to entering the court area. The Association is utilising the Service NSW check in system.

***Every spectator must register their attendance at the venue. QR codes are displayed at all entry points to the courts, around the fence line, on the toilet block and on the buildings.***

Any Parent or Spectator who does not have access to the Service NSW check in system must register their attendance with the scorers of the game that they are watching.

Parents and Spectators are to observe **Social Distancing of 1.5 metres** if they are not from the same household.

**At the completion of the game, parents and spectators should collect their children and leave the venue immediately. If attending another game at the next time slot, then proceed straight to the game court.**

**Clubs:**

A designated official from each club must always be available during the day. No allocated car spaces are available for club committees.

**Drink Bottles:**

All drink bottles must be marked with the individual's name. No drink bottle is to be shared. If bottles are purchased from the canteen, the person who buys them must record their name on the bottle.

**At the end of the game, all drink bottles must be removed from the court.**

**No lost property will be collected. Any items left at the venue will be disposed of.**

**Hygiene:**

Players should use hand sanitiser before, during and after the game. Each team will be provided with a bottle.

Coaches must check on participants' health before playing and ask relevant questions about individual health and travel – refer to Netball New South Wales Covid-19 Safety Plan Return to Play Guidelines.

**REMINDER:** There are to be **NO** team handshakes prior to start of the game. There are to be **NO** team huddles, handshakes and high fives or multiplayer celebrations.

There is to be **NO** spitting.

CDNA have also place hand sanitiser stations around the courts and building.

**Wellbeing of Staff and Visitors:**

No player, coach, official or spectator is to come to Coronation Park – Minto Netball Complex if they have:

- Been unwell or had any flu like symptoms, or
- Been to an identified "hotspot", or
- Been in contact with a known or suspected case of Covid-19, or
- Had any sudden loss of smell or loss of taste.

Prior to attending the Coronation Park – Minto Netball Complex, all players, coaches, officials and spectators are required to check the NSW Health website and not attend if they have visited any of the locations listed at <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latest-news-and-updates>

No person who is at a high risk from a health perspective, including being elderly or having a pre-existing medical health condition should attend Coronation Park – Minto Netball Complex for competition or training events.

## **Competition operation changes:**

### **Game times:**

CDNA advises you should not attend your court until 15 mins prior to your scheduled game time and players from the previous game time has leave the courts.

8.15am – 10, 12, 14 (*You may head straight to your court*)

9.45am – 11 & 15 (*You may head to court at 9.30am*)

11.15am – NetSetGo (*You may head to your court at 11am*)

12.30pm – 13, Graduates & Walking Netball (*You may head to your court at 12.15pm*)

1.55pm – Divisions 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 (*You may head to your court at 1.40pm*)

3.20pm – Divisions 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 (*You may head to your court at 3.05pm*)

At the completion of the game, all players and spectators are required to immediately exit the venue. If attending another game at the next time slot, then proceed straight to the game court.

### **Umpire Sign-on:**

Umpires will sign on each week as per normal procedure

### **Player Sign-on:**

Score boards will be issued to scorers before the commencement of the game. Scorers will record their names on the scoresheet in block capitals not with a signature.

Each player must have their nails checked by the umpire.

All players must sign on each week. (*as per CDNA by-laws*)

Each scorer must provide their own pen. No pens are to be returned with scoreboards.

### **Late Arrivals to Games:**

When a player arrives after the commencement of the game, then that player must have their nails checked by the umpire and sign on the scoresheet.

### **Scoreboards:**

At the completion of the game, the scorer for the winning side will return the scoreboard to the Registrar's window.

## **ADMINISTRATION BUILDING**

### **General Walkways:**

General Public access to Canteen, BBQ, Registrars, Umpires and First Aid.  
Social distancing of 1.5 metres to be observed by the ground markings.

### **Canteen and BBQ Area:**

Observe and follow Directions and Ground Markings when lining up at the Canteen and BBQ.

### **Registrars:**

When returning Score Boards to Control after conclusion of game, place on Counter and leave the area.

The registrars will then remove the scoresheet and sanitise the board ready for the next lot of games. (if needed)

### **First Aid:**

Observe and follow directions and ground markings when attending the First Aid Room.

### **Toilets:**

Social distancing of 1.5 metres to be observed. Please make sure you are in and out of the toilets to avoid congestion and groups gathering. Make sure all children are not playing in or around the toilets.
